





# JLN as a Global Source of UHC Knowledge


The JLN and its member countries have published over 60 knowledge products that address the practical how-to's of universal health coverage reforms.










## JLN Toolkit: Using Data Analytics to Monitor Health Provider Payment Systems





#### **The Need**

## Why a toolkit?

#### The Reality

- Most JLN countries implementing new or planning refinements to existing provider payment systems
- These systems rely on and generate large amounts of data, (provider claims and other routine reporting systems)
- Performance measures needed to monitor access, quality and effectiveness of services and efficiency of resource use

- M&E for provider payment is rarely adequate in practice; little guidance available from international experience
- Many countries do not use claims data and other routinely collected information to their fullest potential
- Issues include:
  - Data are held by different agencies
  - Purchasing entity lacks the staffing capacity or expertise


#### Joint Collaborative with JLN PPM& IT Initiatives

#### The Process

- Virtual collaboration and 3 inperson workshops
- Country representatives shared experience, expertise, and challenges related to monitoring health provider payment systems

#### The Product

- Facilitators collected best practices for developing indicators with real-life lessons from countries
- Final product (April 2017): toolkit that offers guidance, tools, templates, and other resources





#### **Toolkit Framework**





#### How does the toolkit achieve objectives?

- Presents a framework to identify and prioritize questions to monitor provider payment systems, generating and analyzing the data, and using the routine monitoring systems for decision making
- Provides practical tools based on country experiences for countries to adapt and use the framework to build their own provider payment monitoring systems
